Holy Qur'an:

He it is Who has **raised** among the Unlettered *people* a Messenger from among themselves who recites unto them His Signs, and purifies them, and teaches them the Book and wisdom, although they had been, before, in manifest misguidance;

And *among* others from among them who have not yet joined them. He is the Mighty, the Wise. (62: 3-4)

Sayings of the Holy Prophet (saw):

'Isa son of Mary will descend, then he will get married and offspring will be born to him.' In another Hadith the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) said: 'What will your condition be when the advent of Isa, son of Mary will take place, who will be your Imam and will be from among you.' He also said, 'Whoso among you lives shall meet Isa, son of Mary, who will be the 'Judge' and the 'Arbiter' and will break the Cross and kill the swine'.

Writings of the Promised Messiah (as):

'I confer upon thee a sign of My mercy according to thy entreaties and have honoured thy prayers with acceptance through My mercy and have blessed this thy journey. A Sign of power, mercy and nearness to Me is bestowed on thee, a Sign of grace and beneficence is awarded to thee, and thou art granted the key of success and victory. Peace on thee, O victorious one. Thus does God speak so that those who desire life may be rescued from the grip of death, and those who are buried in the graves may emerge there from, so that the superiority of Islam and the dignity of God's Word may become manifest unto the people and so that truth may arrive with all its blessings and falsehood may depart with all its ills; so that people may understand that I am the Lord of Power and do what I will and so that they may believe that I am with thee, and so that those who do not believe in God and deny and reject His religion and His Book and His Holy Messenger, Muhammad the chosen one, on whom be peace, may be confronted with a clear Sign and the way of the guilty ones may become manifest.

Rejoice, therefore, that a handsome and pure boy will be bestowed on thee. Thou wilt receive an intelligent youth who will be of thy seed and will be of thy progeny. A handsome and pure boy will come as your guest. His name is Emmanuel and Bashir. He has been invested with a holy spirit, and he will be free from all impurity. He is the light of Allah. Blessed is he who comes

from heaven. He will be accompanied by grace which shall arrive with him. He will be characterized by grandeur, greatness and wealth. He will come into the world and will heal many of their ills through his Messianic qualities and through the blessings of the Holy Spirit. He is the Word of Allah, for Allah's mercy and honour have equipped him with the Word of Majesty. He will be extremely intelligent and understanding and will be meek of heart and will be filled with secular and spiritual knowledge. He will convert three into four (of this the meaning is not clear). It is Monday, a blessed Monday. Son, delight of the heart, high ranking, noble; a manifestation of the First and the Last, a manifestation of the True and the High; as if Allah has descended from heaven. His advent will be greatly blessed and will be a source of the manifestation of Divine Majesty. Behold a light cometh, a light anointed by God with the perfume of His pleasure. He will pour His spirit upon him and he will be sheltered under the shadow of God. He will grow rapidly in stature and will be the means of procuring the release of those held in bondage. His fame will spread to the ends of the earth and people will be blessed through him. He will then be raised to his spiritual station in heaven. This is a matter decreed.'

Synopsis of Friday sermon Delivered by Hadhrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad ^{atba}, Supreme Head of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, February 20th, 2009

The Promised Messiah (on whom be peace) was addressed by God as 'one who Allah Himself appointed' (*JareeUllah*). From his childhood Allah inclined him to a deep love of God, the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) and Islam. He had studied all world religions and was ever engaged in proving the superiority of Islam over them.

On 20th February 1886, after his forty days of intense prayer were over, the Promised Messiah (on whom be peace) published a leaflet with a prophecy that God had revealed to him in the forty days.

Hudhur then read the words of the prophecy. (Provided above)

This 'Promised Son' was born on 12th January 1889 and was named Mirza Bashir ud din Mahmood Ahmad. The prophecy was fulfilled in this great son with immense glory and the world witnessed it. The period of his Khilafat spanned fifty two years during which the Community spread further than the shores of India and was established in several countries of the world. Hudhur said it is impossible to encompass the achievements of the era of Hadhrat Musleh Maud (may Allah be pleased with him), who did not announce that he indeed was the 'Musleh Maud' until God informed him. He made the announcement in 1944.
