Holy Qur'an:

O ye who believe! Turn to Allah in sincere repentance. It may be that your Lord will remove the evil consequences of your deeds and make you enter Gardens through which rivers flow, on the day when Allah will not abase the Prophet nor those who have believed with him.

(Chapter 66, Verse 9)

Sayings of the Holy Prophet (saw):

Anas ibn Malik (ra), servant of the Holy Prophet (saw), said: Allah is more pleased with the repentance of a servant of His than would be one of you who were to lose his riding camel, which carries his food and drink, in a barren desert, and losing all hope of finding it he were to lie down in the shade of a tree, and then should suddenly find it standing near him and should seize its nose-string and in his excess of joy should blurt out: O Allah, Thou art my servant and I am Thy lord. *(Bokhari and Muslim)*

Writings of the Promised Messiah (as):

Some people are such that they are confronted with problems such as their jobs or some other reason because of which a greater part of their lives is spent in darkness. They can not pay any attention towards the offering of prayers and neither do they find an opportunity to hear the Word of Allah or the Sayings of the Prophet. The thought of pondering over the Book of Allah does not even cross their minds. When a long time has passed in such darkness, then such thoughts having been deeply rooted become their second nature. At that time, if such a person does not turn towards repentance and seek forgiveness, then he would be very unfortunate. The best cure for negligence and laziness is istighfaar. If one is afflicted with hardships because of the past negligence and laziness then one should get up in the middle of the night and lay in prostration before the Almighty God and pray; and in the presence of Allah, make a promise of a clean and true change in oneself. *(Translated from Malfoozat, Volume 1, pages 300-301)*

Three conditions for repentance

1. Evil thoughts and fancies should be discarded.
2. Remorse.
3. Firm resolve that you will not revert to those vices.
