Surah Al-Kahf Brtrdrd 01-04; Surah Ha Meem Sajdah verses 34-36**

- The marking will be based on Tajweed, *Ramooz-e-Auqaf* and *Qira'at*.
- Extra points will be awarded for reciting from memory

### Nazm

Three couplets from any of the following poems can be recited:

**Mahasan-e-Quran-e-Kareem - Durre Sameen** – From

*Jo khak mein mille use milta he aashna* up to another 10 verses.

**Nonehalan ne Jama'at – Kalam-e-Mahmood** – From the beginning.

**Waqt kam he Bohat kam he Chalho – Kalam-e-Tahir** - From the beginning.

- Each contestant will be permitted 2 minutes
- The marking will be based on pronunciation, tune and the quality of voice

### Adhan

- Each contestant will be permitted 90 seconds
- The marking will be based on pronunciation, tune and the quality of voice
