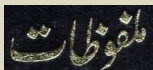
### Hadith

## Extract of Friday Sermon

Today, who but the Ahmadiyya Community can encompass the tragedy of Karbala. In the aforementioned poetic verse two individuals are mentioned; both professed the Kalima (Muslim declaration of faith). Yet one comprehended the reality of the Kalima and was a victim, and the other perpetrated cruelty while disregarding the Kalima. Hadhrat Hussein (may Allah be pleased with him), along with his family and a few associates was martyred at Karbala.



This was a continuation from the martyrdom of Hadhrat Usman (may Allah be pleased with him). This is what happens when taqwa lessens, personal gain overrides communal gain and worldly matters are given precedence over faith. The height of barbarity is committed and people of God are murdered in the name of God. People who profess the Kalima persecute other Kalima-followers, children are murdered and all manner of cruelty is perpetrated against people of God who sacrifice their all for God. What could be more unfortunate than to carry out brutality in the name of God and His Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him)? The Qur'an states: 'And whoso kills a believer intentionally, his reward shall be Hell wherein he shall abide. And Allah will be wroth with him and will curse him and will prepare for him a great punishment.' (4:94) God's most intense displeasure for such people is that they will be in Hell for a long period of time and His curse is on them. This is indeed a most grievous punishment and it could not be more unfortunate that a person who professes the Kalima is given such a punishment. On the other hand, God states about those innocents against whom cruelty is perpetrated: '...they are living, in the presence of their Lord, and are granted gifts from Him...' (3:170). Hudhur explained nothing could be a greater reward than this.

## So what is Karbala? And where is it?

Karbala (Arabic: كربلا) is a city in Iraq, located about 100 km (60 mi) southwest of Baghdad, Karbala is the capital of Karbala Governorate, with an estimated population of 572,300 people (2003).

The city is best known as the location of the Battle of Karbala, and is amongst the holiest cities for Shi'ah Muslims after Makkah, Madinah, and Najaf. During the life of Husayn ibn 'Ali, the city was also known as al-Ghadiriyyah, Naynawā, and Shāt al-Furāt. The city contains the Imam Husayn Shrine which is considered sacred by Shias.

There are several theories as to the origin of the name Karbala. One traditional hypothesis is geographer Yaqut al-Hamawi's belief that the name is an alternate Arabic feminine version of karbalah "soft earth".[1]. Another theory is that the name came from the Aramaic root Karb or Qarb; meaning "Near", and Alah; meaning God. Hence, the word 'Karbala' signifies 'Near God'. [2] Also, some historians stated that it was derived from the word "Kora", place for making bricks, for the famous ancient city of "Babil", Hence (( Korebabil) ).
