Delivered by Hadhrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (atba) on November 27th 2009.

Huzur (atba) gave a discourse on the manifestation of God being **Wali** of the pious and devout followers of Prophets of God in his Sermon. He said due to the power of the holiness of the Prophet (S.A.W.) the manifestation of God being a **Wali** of believers could be seen among his followers.

When God sent the Promised Messiah (as) he too witnessed many instances of God being his **Wali**.

Huzur gave example that once some Companions of the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.) were deceptively asked by people of a tribe to provide them with religious training, but instead martyred them. One of the martyrs was Ahsan bin Thabit. After taking the life of Ahsan the enemy tried to get hold of his head because a woman of the enemy had vowed to drink alcohol in his skull because he had killed her two sons at the Battle of Uhad. However, a swarm of bees came in between the enemy and where Ahsan's body lay. The enemy decided to return at night to take his body. Heavy rain fell

during night and there was flooding which swept Ahsan's body away. After accepting Islam Ahsan had pledged that he would never touch an idolater and also would not allow an idolater to touch him. When Hadhrat Umar (may Allah be pleased with him) was informed of this incident, he said 'God protects believers'. Thus God protected Ahsan even after death.

Which is the Tallest Mountain in the World? You might say Mount Everest!

No, you're wrong! Mount Everest is the Highest Mountain in the World, But not the tallest!

"Mauna Kea" an inactive volcano in the US state of Hawaii, is just 4,207metres (13,803 ft) high, compared to Mt. Everest's 8,848 metres (29,029 ft) measuring both from mean sea level, but, is the tallest mountain in the World. Because Mauna Kea is 10,203 m (33,476 ft) above its base on the floor of the Pacific Ocean; about three-quarters of a mile taller than Mt. Everest. This makes Mauna Kea the world's tallest mountain by this measure, taller than Mt. Everest, which is the highest mountain above sea level.
