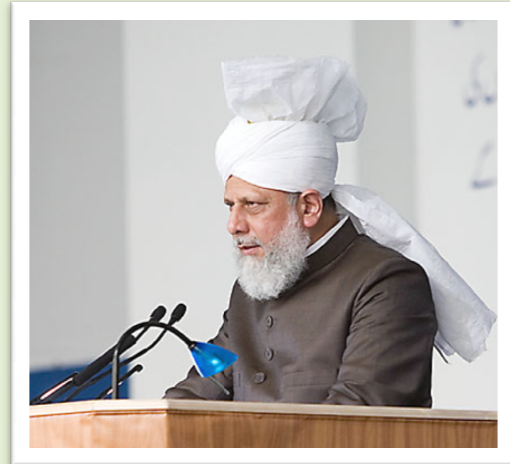

Extract of Friday Sermon

Huzur (atba) delivered the Friday sermon on September 30, 2011 at Masjid Bait-ul-Nasar, in Furuset, Oslo, Norway and officially inaugurated the mosque before the Friday Sermon. Huzur (atba) began his sermon by reciting a verse of the Holy Quran (9:18) and then by announcing the official inauguration of the beautiful mosque. He said that the Norwegian Jamaat had to meet and overcome many obstacles, due



to which the construction was stalled and took a long time to complete. However, the construction of mosques is not dependent on its inauguration. The fact that Huzur (atba) has officially inaugurated the mosque is just an outward expression of gratitude to Allah, Who commands us that when He bestows us with blessings, we should express our gratefulness in return of these rewards. Allah Almighty then makes us heirs to greater blessings. One way of expression of gratitude is through prayers and supplication, and another way is through our overt expression. However, the real gratitude comes through populating the mosques and filling them with prayers. It is incumbent upon every Ahmadi Muslim to remember this very important principle. Allah Almighty then rewards this gratitude manifold.

A Hadith, narrated by Hadhrat Abu Hurairah (ra), says that the Holy Prophet (saw) said: Whoever goes to the masjid in the morning or in the evening, Allah prepares for him a good hospitality in Paradise as often as he goes to the masjid, morning or evening. (Bukhari) In view of this Hadith, one can only imagine the type of hospitality he would receive if he goes to the masjid five times a day in an average life span (50-60 years of offering salat). Huzur (atba) said that when we receive guests in our homes, we make every effort to serve them to the best of our ability, even when our resources are limited. But there are no limitations to the resources or the mercy of Allah Almighty; we can only imagine what His hospitality would be like. We should try to gain every such opportunity so that we can reap His promised blessings. Huzur (atba) said that he hopes that each Ahmadi Muslim will try to increase his or her efforts to gain these blessings, and dutifully fulfil his obligations towards Allah and fellow human beings. These efforts will pave the way to establishing a good society in our surroundings.

Life of Prophet: Musa (as)

Israelites were living in bondage in Egypt. The King had subjected them to very hard and difficult conditions. To perpetuate their control over Israelites, one of the measures taken against them was that the male children of Israelites be slain. The King had ordered the midwives to carry out this evil task quietly at the very birth of the children of Israelites (Exodus 1:16). But the will of God prevented the midwives from such an evil act. When the King came to know of this, he gave order to his people, saying,

“Every son that is born ye shall cast into river, and every daughter ye shall save alive.” (Exodus 1:22)

We have in the Holy Quran,

“ ... Pharaoh behaved arrogantly in the earth, and divided the people thereof into sections; he sought to weaken one section of them, slaughtering their sons and sparing there women... ” (28:5)
