Tilawat

- Any of the following verses can be recited:
 - Surah Al-Tin
 - Surah Al-Qadr
 - Surah Al-Fil
 - Surah Al-Asr
- This will be an open competition
- The marking will be based on *qira'at*, *ramooz e auqaf* and *quality of voice*
- Extra points will be awarded for reciting from memory

Nazm

- Three couplets from any of the following poems can be recited
 - Wo Peshwa Hamara
 - Mahmud ki Amin
 - Kabhi Nusrat Nahin Milti
- This will be an open competition
- Each contestant will be permitted 2 minutes
- The marking will be based on pronunciation, tune and the quality of voice
- Contestants should be able to present a start, middle and ending of Nazm in their given time

Prepared Speech Competition

- 7 -11: Salaat, Birthdays, Truthfulness
- 12-15: Helping the less well off, Sacrifice in the cause of Allah, Respect for teachers
- This will be an open competition
- Each contestant will be given 2 minutes to speak on a selected topic with 2 minutes of preparation time
- The marking will be based on contents and presentation style

Adhan

- This will be an open competition
- Each contestant will be permitted 2 minutes
- The marking will be based on pronunciation, tune and the quality of voice

Ta'leem Quiz

- This will be an open competition
- Religious knowledge questions will be taken from the list of questions provided to atfal before the ijtema.
- Quiz will also include some General Knowledge questions
